Dear Mr. Baio:

It has come to our attention that your website, www.waxy.org, is displaying scanned copies of Opus comic strips. It is my understanding that you have neither sought nor received permission from The Washington Post Writers Group to reproduce and distribute these comic strips.

As you may know, any organization or person that wishes to reprint or distribute articles published by The Washington Post Writers Group, all of which are copyrighted material, is legally required to obtain permission from The Washington Post Writers Group before doing so. Your unauthorized reproduction and distribution of Opus comic strips is a violation of federal copyright law.

This letter constitutes a formal request that you cease and desist from copying and displaying any Opus comic strips without permission from The Washington Post Writers Group. Please respond immediately to confirm that your unauthorized display of copyrighted material has ceased and will not be repeated.
